Dear participants,

Dear students, dear teachers,

We are looking forward to welcome you at our European youth encounter European Democratic Action Week (EDAW) from 7th to 12st October 2024. This year we invite students aged 14 to 18 years old from Germany, Poland, Czech Republic, Italy, Romania and Ukraine. The participants must have a good command of the English language, as the youth encounter will be held in English.

Accommodation

The accommodation is the youth education centre Störitzland nearby Berlin (https://www.stoeritzland.de) in Brandenburg, workshops and activities mainly take place in there and in the Berlin district Treptow-Köpenick. The transport between Störitzland and Berlin will be organized and accompanied.

If you are travelling by train, please get off at **Fangschleuse station until 4 p.m.** We will pick you up from there. If you are travelling by plane, we will discuss the pick-up from BER airport individually.

All participants will be accommodated in shared rooms with WC and showers. Young people from different countries are accommodated in one room. **Towels and bed linen are NOT provided there.**

Topic

Overcoming boundaries - 'My boundaries are not your boundaries, your borders are not my borders. Then what connects us?'

Under the topic of 'Overcoming boundaries', we recognise that the challenges are not only personal in nature, but also have social and global dimensions. Among the current challenges, it is important to look beyond our own horizons and show empathy for others. We must recognise that we are all part of a European community and that tackling many problems requires cooperation and solidarity on a global level. It is therefore important to support young people in forming a European identity, in addition to strengthening them on a personal level. They should learn that they are connected as a diverse community in global events. Together they are exposed to problems, but together they are also stronger.







Preparation

Each delegation member is asked to think about the questions:

- 1. What does freedom mean to you personally?
- 2. How do you approach people who have a completely different perspective to you?
- 3. Where and how do people from different groups come together in your society?

Please create **a video as a group** in which you provide answers to the questions. The video should **not be longer than 1 minute in total**. Please send the video <u>one week before the event</u>.

For the international dinner we ask you to bring **typical snacks from your country and -** <u>one</u> <u>week before the event</u> - **a traditional recipe**. You should also prepare a **presentation** (no longer than 5 minutes) **of your region or country**.

Permissions

Everyone being under 18 years needs a permission signed by his parents or legal guardian. It allows you to swim and it allows us to take photos for the documentation of the project. These papers are <u>attached to this information letter</u>. Please send them signed until 27th of September.
